C.W.P.C.A. MEMBERS ROSETTES will be awarded in All Classes to the highest placed member. For identification purposes exhibitors should wear a red ribbon on their arm, but Membership Cards <u>MUST</u> be presented in the ring. (Not to be signed by the Judge)

Numbers collected from the Show Secretary on show day.

The Committee cannot be held responsible for any clash of classes involving the same exhibit or exhibitor.

SHOW RULES

- 1. The Committee does not hold itself responsible for any accident to any person, animal or vehicle and exhibitors are advised to arrange appropriate cover.
- 2. Entry Fee to accompany entry form to be forwarded to the Show Secretary by the stated closing date.
- 3. The Committee reserves the right to cancel or alter the order of classes as required.
- 4. The Committee reserves the right to refuse any entry and its decision is final in all disputes.
- 5. The Judge's decision is final in all classes.
- 6. No entry fees returned.
- 7. All competitors are expected to know, to understand and to follow the Rules and Regulations under which their classes are judged.
- 8. Any person may submit a protest. All protests shall be made in writing to the Show Secretary within ONE HOUR of the judging of the particular class. All protests must be accompanied by a deposit of £10 (TEN POUNDS) which shall be returned if the protest is substantiated, otherwise to be forfeited to the Show. This rule shall be strictly adhered to.
- 9. All Cups and Trophies to be returned to the Show Secretary by ONE MONTH prior to the Show. (IN A CLEAN CONDITION PLEASE).
- 10. No person other than the handler and officials to be allowed in the ring.
- 11. Members should wear a Red Arm Ribbon and <u>MUST</u> present their Membership Cards to be eligible for a Members Rosette.
- 12. No mucking out of trailers / horse boxes on field or yard.
- 13. Hard hats must be worn at ALL times when mounted.
- 14. The CWPCA Show is run under WPCS Rules.
- 15. Exhibitors should conduct themselves at all times in an orderly, polite manner as they represent the Welsh breeds and consequently the CWPCA. Bad language is not tolerated under any circumstances whether to fellow Exhibitors, Owners or Producers, Judges, Stewards or Show Officials. Bad behaviour brings the Society into disrepute. A courteous manner is expected at all times. Judges should not be approached on the day of the show. This is extended to include people's conduct on social media in relation to Clwyd WPCA events. Failure to comply could result in action being taken by the Association.

RHEOLAU'R SIOE

- 1. Nid yw'r Pwyllgor yn dal ei hun yn gyfrifol am unrhyw ddamwain i unrhyw berson, anifail na cherbyd. Cynghorir arddangoswyr i drefnu yswiriant priodol.
- 2. Y tal cystadlu i'w anfon ynghyd a'r ffurflen gais cystadlu at yr Ysgrifenydd Sioe.
- 3. Mae'r Pwyllgor yn cadw'r hawl i ddileu, neu i newid trefn gweithgareddau yn ôl y gofyn.

- 4. Mae'r Pwyllgor yn cadw'r hawl i wrthod unrhyw gais cystadlu. Ymhob anghydfod mae unrhyw benderfyniad a wneir gan y Pwyllgor yn derfynol.
- 5. Bydd dyfarniad y Beirniad ymhob cystadleuaeth yn derfynol.
- 6. Ni Fydd unrhyw ad-dallad o dal cystadlu.
- 7. Mae disgwyl i gystadleuwyr wybod, deall a dilyn rheolau a rheolau'r dosbarth y bernir hwynt ynddo.
- Mae hawl gan unrhyw berson i wrthdystio. Cyflwynir pob gwrthdystiad ar bapur i'r Ysgrifennydd Sioe o fewn UN AWR i feirniadu'r dosbarth dan sylw. Rhaid cynnwys blaendal o £10 (DEG PUNT) gyda phob cwyn dilys; fel arall bydd yr arian yn cael ei fforffedu ac yn eiddo i'r Sioe. Cedwir yn gaeth at y rheol yma.
- 9. Pob cwpan, Tarian a Thlws i'w ddychwelyd i'r Ysgrifennydd Sioe ERBYN UN MIS cyn y Sioe os gwelwch yn dda.
- 10. Nid oes gan neb ond y swyddogion a'r unigolion sy'n trin, yr hawl i fod yn y cylch.
- 11. I fod yn gymwys i dderbyn Rhosglwm Aelod, mae'n rhaid i aelodau wisgo'r rhwymyn braich swyddogol a chyflwyno'u Cardiau Aelodaeth.
- 12. Dim glanhau bocs ceffylau / cartiau-ol yn y cae neu yn yr iard.
- 13. Hetiau caled i gael eu gwisgo bob amser tra yn marchogaeth.
- 14. Mae sioe CMCCC yn cael ei rhedeg o dan reolau'r GMCC.
- 15. Dylai arddangoswyr ymddwyn bob amser yn drefnus ac yn gwrtais wrth gynrychioli bridiau Cymreig ac felly'r GMCC. Ni chaniateir iaith anweddus o gwbl wrth siarad a chydarddangoswyr, perchnogion a chynhyrchwyr, beirniaid, stiwardiaid na swyddogion sioeau. Mae ymddygiad gwael yn rhoi enw drwg i'r Gymdeithas. Disgwylir ymddygiad cwrtais bob amser. Ni ddylech fynd at feirniaid ar ddiwrnod y sioe. Caiff hyn ei ymestyn i gynnwys ymddygiad pobl ar gyfryngau cymdeithasol mewn perthynas â digwyddiadau CMCC. Gallai methu â chydymffurfio arwain at gamau'n cael eu cymryd gan y Gymdeithas.
